Notes for the completion of this form

From the 2nd March 2009, the WIA under contract arrangements with the Australian Communications and Media Authority (ACMA) has taken responsibility for all amateur callsign administration.

In undertaking this role the WIA will incur costs that the ACMA has agreed may be reasonably recovered. The cost associated with issuing a Callsign Recommendation for a two letter callsign in New South Wales, Queensland and Victoria reflect the fact that there are now very few two letter callsigns available and so they have become highly desirable and there is significant competition for their allocation. ACMA has accepted that extra administrative arrangements by the WIA are necessary to ensure that, to the extent possible, all applications are treated fairly.

The fee for the issue of a Level 3 recommendation is **\$48.00** including GST. That fee must accompany the application. A Level 3 Recommendation means that you can select a two letter callsign in NSW, Queensland and Victoria, from the Public List of Available Callsigns that appears on the WIA website. This List is updated daily.

In the event that more than one person seeks a Recommendation in respect of the same two letter callsign within 7 Working Days of that callsign being placed on the Public List, a ballot will be conducted in accordance with the "Complete Guide to Callsigns" on the WIA website.

In the event that your selection is not available, you will be contacted by the WIA and a further selection may be possible, otherwise your fee will be refunded.

If you consider the normal validity period of 28 days for a recommendation is insufficient, please provide the reasons on a separate page and attach to the application form and also tick Yes in answer to D "Is there any other information attached to this application?"

If you are applying for an Australian amateur licence on the basis of a foreign qualification or current foreign amateur licence, please attach a certified copy of the foreign qualification or current foreign licence, and if the document is not in the English language a certified translation of the document, and also a certified copy of the photo page of your passport and also tick Yes in answer to D "Is there any other information attached to this application?"

The Recommendation by the WIA of a callsign remains valid for 28 days. In the event that you cannot make your application for a licence or variation of a licence to ACMA within this period, please contact the WIA office for an extension. If a callsign Recommendation lapses after the expiry period, the callsign is placed on the WIA Public List of Available Callsigns.

Remember:

- Print clearly, illegible, unclear or incomplete application forms may delay processing
- Cheques and money orders should be made payable to the Wireless Institute of Australia
- Attach any other documents to the application form

When applications are made to the ACMA either for a licence or a variation to an existing licence, the original WIA Recommendation must accompany the application.
