8. PRESIDENTS ADDRESS

Last year I stood in front of you with my “P” plates on and although I haven’t quite progressed to the heavy rigid endorsement I am getting there. I am pleased to report that the Board has also progressed a number of initiatives in relation to our ambitious change agenda.

The new Board took on the task of rebuilding and stabilising the WIA and this has been successful from a finance and administration perspective. We have been able to deliver a small surplus in 2018 and the 2019 budget indicates a small deficit in the 2019 year, in spite of a forecast spending of over \$50,000 sending delegates to the World Radio Conference.

Last year the Strategy Advisory Committee ran a survey of amateurs which clearly told the board that the main reason that people are members of the WIA is because of the WIA’s role as the peak body representing amateur radio to National and International regulating and governing bodies. WIA representatives have attended more than eight national and international meetings to prepare for the

World Radio Conference 2019 in October. This is a huge commitment and an expensive undertaking - members have told us this is what they expect their memberships to be spent on.

The WIA will continue to vigorously advocate and educate the regulator to ensure that they are fully aware of their obligations in the amateur service space. The WIA never wastes an opportunity to remind the regulators and decision makers about the global federation of national associations of radio amateurs in more than 150 countries. This being the International Amateur Radio Union that has been providing frequency coordination services for the amateur service and satellites free of charge for many years.

We are well on the way to revitalising the committee and governance arrangements of the Institute. This has taken the form of some new and rejuvenated committee structures. The Board used to “bang on” about steering the organisation not rowing the organisation and this in most part has been achieved with the Board leaving the operational and administrative elements of running the Institute to the respective committees and teams. Board members are part of some of these teams however, they are not chairing these teams, they are there to support these teams. The focus of the committee revitalisation program has now turned to the technical committees.

The Board has been working actively on improving the value proposition for members and affiliated clubs. This has seen our affiliated clubs increase to 151 in 2018. Broader insurance options being available to affiliated clubs is one option being actively investigated to improve the value-add service.

Membership, however, is still a work in progress, as the WIA only attracted 191 new members in 2018 and we sadly lost over 50 members who became silent keys. Using the 151 affiliated clubs and the insurance coverage that the WIA facilitates demonstrates that the WIA only represents one third of the amateur radio population in VK. To enable the WIA as the National Amateur Representative body to approach and work with the government and the regulator to the benefit of the hobby, we need strong representative membership. This will be a continuing challenge for the new Board.

The Institute’s IT Group is currently undertaking a technology refresh that will see a more flexible and cheaper IT platform to facilitate and build automation into many of the Institute’s functions. This refresh will see cloud technology used to improve member services and automation. This will also reduce the IT overhead costs for the organisation and provide a more secure and lower risk profile for the Institute.

One of the first values adds that is currently being trialled is membership access to the corporate version of Google Suite. This is a practical value-add for members. Another area that has already been implemented is the ticketing system that is currently being rolled out into all areas of the WIA. This system enables the Institute to log, track, workflow and report all its functions and member services. Importantly, it enables categorisation and workflow to ensure these calls end up with the right committee or person for action. The ticketing system also enables the Board to see in real-time what is happening within the Institute and address issues in a timely manner.

Other IT focused improvements will see higher value membership services introduced that will not necessarily be amateur radio related. The website is about to be overhauled along with the social media interfaces and the automation of many existing and future membership services.

The WIA has met with the ACMA many times to discuss the future of amateur radio licencing, the implementation of the new Radio Communications Act, implementation of the new parameter-based licencing and the formation of the Syllabus Review committee. The WIA is continuing to push the

ACMA to speed up the implementation of a reformed Licence Conditions Determination and getting secondary access to 60 metres.

The relationship with the ACMA is a precarious one - on the one hand the ACMA is divesting itself of everything administrative and this provides opportunities. This is due to resourcing constraints placed on the organisation and this creates a shift from an organisational culture of prescriptive technical regulation to an organisation that runs and promotes enabling legislation and policy with industry driven self-managing frameworks. This ACMA divestment represents a real challenge and risk for the amateur community. These manifests itself in what appears to be the regulators' decreasing responsiveness to all things amateur radio when in fact this is due to the amateur community's lack of acceptance of a self-regulation trajectory. This change will be challenging for the amateur community however it will be a necessary one.

One area of pain that the Institute has addressed is reducing the backlog of repeater assignments. This work is currently being undertaken by commercial frequency assigners on behalf of the WIA as a pilot process. The learnings from the pilot process will inform the long-term process that the WIA will adopt and may see the WIA having its own team of frequency assigners.

Towards the end of 2018 the ACMA tendered for assessment and callsign services and the WIA Education Group submitted a comprehensive and future focussed response that demonstrated how these services could be delivered in a more effective and efficient way to serve the amateur radio community. Unfortunately, the WIA was not successful and the Board considers this to be a lost opportunity with no net community benefit. The Board supports the diversification of assessment services as this enables the ACMA to more comprehensively meet their charter to supply amateur assessment services within Australia.

The WIA today, more than 100 years since it was founded, exists entirely due to the continuing contribution of many volunteers over many generations - consider becoming one of these volunteers and contribute, even in a small way, to the future of this great hobby.

I finish off by announcing that the WIA will be introducing the Brenda Edmonds WIA Education Award. Brenda's family has given permission to create an award in her name with a focus on education to the amateur radio community. The WIA looks forward to receiving nominations for this award in 2020.

Finally, I would like to say a huge thank you to my fellow Board members who have supported me through the last year along with the many volunteers that support the Institute. Lastly, I thank the amateur radio community for the opportunity to serve as WIA President and Director for the last two years and look forward to continuing my involvement in a number of areas.
