Errata and Corrections

We bring the following information to the attention of readers, to highlight errors in article preparation and bring attention to corrections, for which we apologise. The following are pertinent to **Issue 2**, Vol. 93, No. 2, March/April, and **Issue 3**, Vol. 93, No. 3, May/June.

ISSUE 2

EMR station safety, pp33-37

On **page 33**, the author, Phil Wait VK2ASD, is a WIA Education Committee member, not the Chair who is Amanda Hawes VK1WX.

Further, on the same page, third column, second paragraph, the word **systematic** is incorrect and should be changed to **systemic**, so that the paragraph reads:

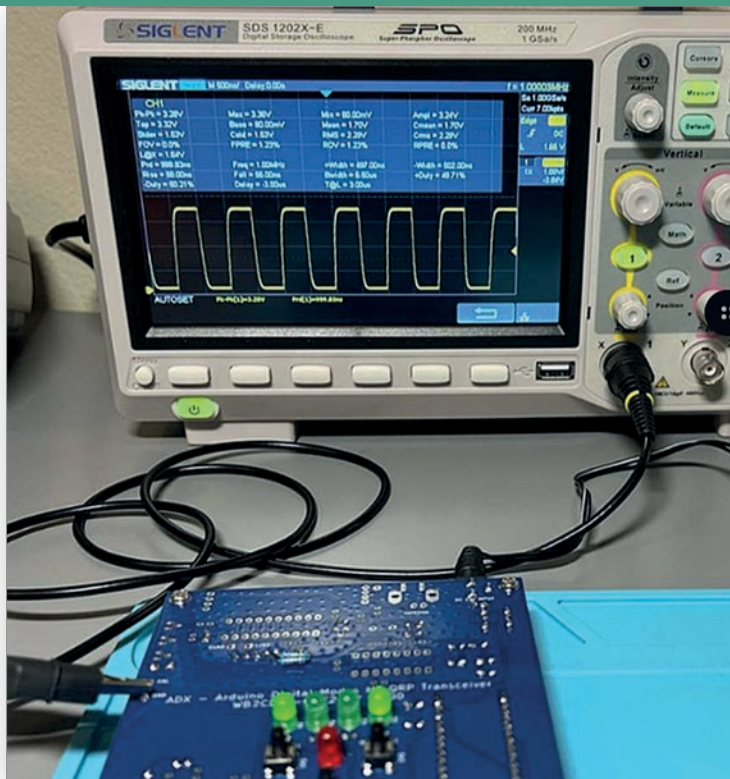
However, in 2024 the World Health Organisation (WHO) commissioned a **systemic** review into the potential health effects of EMR. A **systemic** review is one where all available research on a topic is identified and amalgamated to provide a comprehensive overview, with transparency and reproducibility.

Similarly, the third paragraph should read:

Further, the review found “no association between mobile phone use and head cancers,” and “the findings of this **systemic** review align with previous research conducted by ARPANSA...”

The first paragraph at the head of the column on **page 35**, about the RSGB EMR calculator is incorrect, arising from a copy editing mistake. At this time, the ACMA has not accepted or approved the RSGB calculator. The paragraph has been removed in the PDF edition. When the issue was published and the error was noted, the WIA apologised to both the ACMA and the author.

ADX digi-modes HF transceiver, pp38-43

On advice from the author, Carmel Morris VK2MO, for the sake of accuracy and consistency, the following changes have been made to the PDF edition.

The main photo on **page 38** does not actually show an ADX rig, hence the caption now reads:

Ready portability! A small clamshell case can neatly accommodate your digital rig project along with battery, speaker, and external connectors.

On **Page 40**, there are two photos side-by-side. Inadvertently, we used the wrong photo on the righthand side, which should be the one here above.
