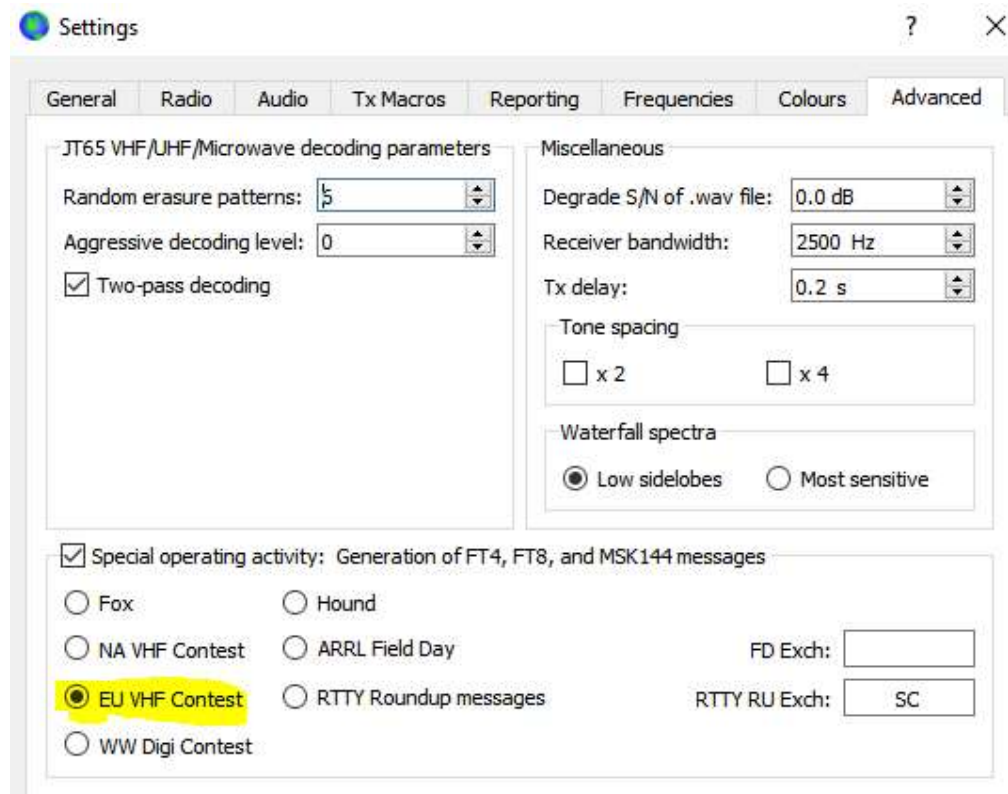


WSJT-X Using the EU VHF Contest Mode with Ross Hull Marathon

The month of January is the annual Ross Hull VHF UHF Marathon.

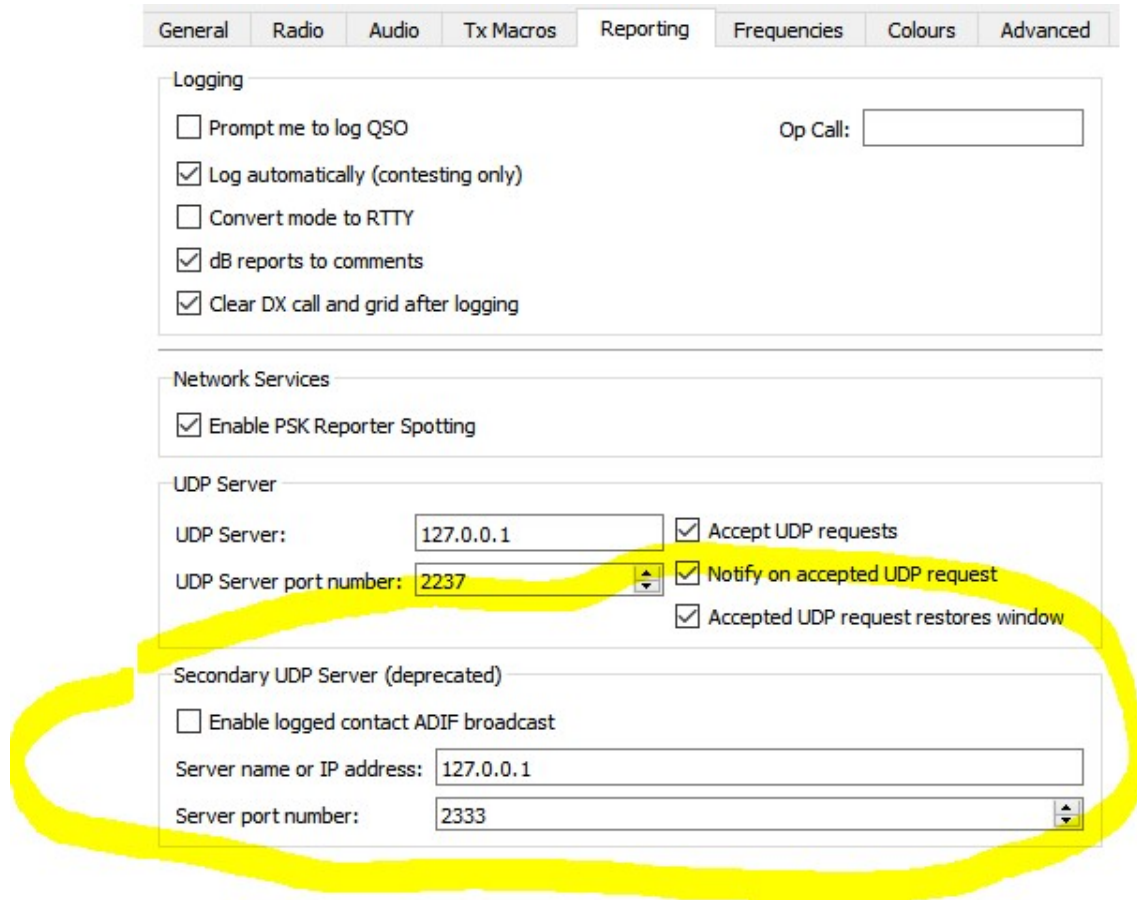
With the upswing of the solar cycle and new players looking at 6M opportunities, FT4 and FT8 operators can enter the contest using WSJT-X in EU VHF Contest mode.



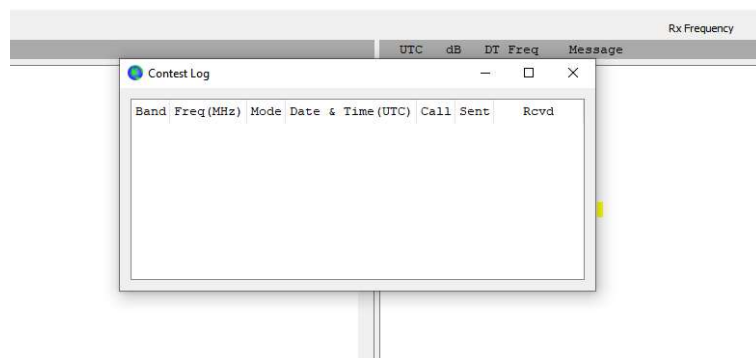
The system generated exchange in EU VHF CONTEST complies with Ross Hull Contest exchange in FT4 or FT8 Mode

CQ TEST G4ABC/P	CQ
G4ABC/P PA9XYZ JO22	Response using 4 digit Grid
PA9XYZ 570123 IO91NP	Response from Run including 6 digit grid
G4ABC/P R 580071 JO22DB	Response from S&P Station with 6 digit grid
PA9XYZ G4ABC/P RR73	Final

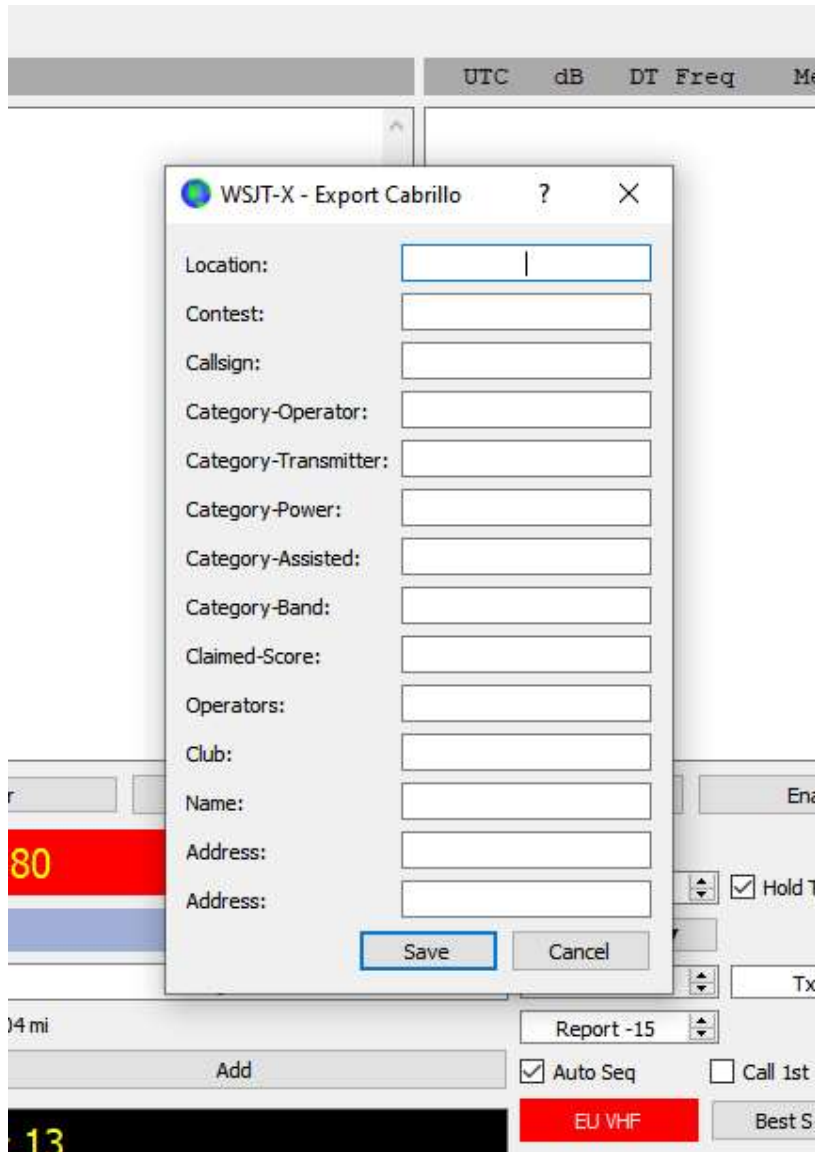
You can use WSJT-X with supported contesting software using UDP server facilities.



Or you can simply log from WSJT-X if you are **only** doing digital modes



At the end of the contest export to Cabrillo from the WSJT-X menu and submit your log



BUT what if you want to use other modes other than FT4 or FT8?
