

Logging made easy for ANZAC 100 stations

Once an ANZAC station has been activated the station the log needs to be filed to the ANZAC Commemorative Callsign Log Uploader.

These logs need to be in the international format, which is known as ADIF, which is the standard for Digital logs which include LoTW, eQSL, ClubLog and QRZ.

All common DX loggers can create ADIF Files - the open standard for exchange of data between ham radio software packages.

The extension of ADIF log file is *.ADI
