#### **WIA Assessment**

A few details regarding the WIA Assessment. All of the WIA assessments are part of a formal process. The Assessments are conducted via a procedure specified by the Wireless Institute of Australia and approved by the Australian Communications and Media Authority.

Does this sound a bit heavy? Don't worry to much as it will all become clear as you read the study material and attend the camp. Very few learners who take the trouble to study and grasp the topics presented in the training material have



problems with the assessment. If you really feel that you need to understand the Assessment process more before the camp, feel free to download the Assessors Instructions, but we feel you would be better to spend your time learning and enjoying your new hobby.

If you intend to sit one of the Amateur Radio Assessments, please Complete the WIA Form 1 Assessment Sheet, Parts 1 & 2 and bring Passport photo and sufficient ID to complete part 7. Note, Foundation Assessment cost are included in the camp fees. Other assessments costs by arrangement.

All participants undertaking the Foundation Training & Assessment will be required to complete the Practical Assessment. The information on this Practical Assessment is a public document and downloaded in advance if you are interested:

#### Common Questions and Answers

#### Q1. Are the Assessment fees included in the camp fees?

A1. The Foundation Assessment Fees and related WIA charges for the Recommendation of the First Available License Call Sign is included in the camp fee of \$395. If you are not undertaking the Assessment or you wish to do one of the other levels of assessment, a variation to the fee will apply.

#### Q2. If I am not staying for the full camp, will I be entitled to a refund?

A2. Withdrawal will incur a minimum of \$100 Administration Fee. Refunds will be negotiated with our Treasurer. \$\mathbb{2}\$

#### Q3. Do I really need to do the training part of the camp?

A3. If you have a Radio and Electronics background or you are just really good at self-study, and you wish to do an assessment, then you may chose to just read the Training Manual and arrange an Assessment. Feel free to discuss with our Training Officer.

#### Q4. I really don't have time to study; can I just turn up to the course?


A4. Yes, but all things worthwhile normally require some work. It is our experience that applicants who don't have a grasp of the subject material will struggle in the training and assessment.

#### Q5. What training material do we use?

A5. Our primary training material is contained in the book "Your Entry Into Amateur Radio - Version 2" pictured. We recommend that you read this book prior to attending the course. This book is included in the Camp Fees and will be mailed to you.

Q6. I was found competent in some of the subjects at a recent course; do I need to do the whole course again?

A6. It depends on how much you remember, please discuss with our Training Officer.



#### Q7. If I do the training, do I need to apply for a license?

A7. While you do need a license to operate a station in your own right, you are entitled to wear the Amateur Radio Badge if you hold the Certificate. Please discuss with our Training Officer.

#### Q8. What happens if I have special diet requirement?

A8. Please be sure to highlight your diet requirement or allergies in the Personal Information Record & Health Statement form.

#### Q9. What are the sleeping arrangements?

A9. Sleeping arrangements will be in accordance with Scouts Australia policies. Scouts under 18 will be segregated from Adults. Please discuss with camp team if you require additional consideration regarding sleeping arrangements.
